

A mother who abandons her baby is a woman in social, psychological or economic difficulty.

She could be an irregular immigrant or an Italian woman afraid of the consequences of an unwanted pregnancy.

The Fondazione Francesca Rava N.P.H. Italia ONLUS and the KPMG Network operating in Italy launched the ninna ho campaign 10 years ago to inform women of the Italian Law 396/2000 and their right to give birth in the security of any public Italian hospital and to not recognize the baby as theirs.

ninna ho is the first national project campaigning for the protection of abandoned babies, for the health and security of mother and child.

ninna ho has the patronage of reputable institutions.

Over the last 10 years it has been campaigning throughout the country to inform and sensitize the public.

ninna ho has donated baby-hatches to 5 Italian hospitals. Other important hospitals with baby-hatches have joined the campaign. Mothers who take the difficult decision that they cannot keep their baby after giving birth can entrust it to a ninna ho baby-hatch.

6 babies have been saved in this way thanks to ninna ho.

Over the next 10 years please help us to help those who need to know that hospitals are a safe alternative to abandoning a baby anywhere else.
